Colour Pop

Maker's image should incorporate a vibrant colour, or colours, that are striking and command the viewer's attention. Your image could incorporate selective colorization where one colour is prominent and the rest of the image is monochrome.

Submission limit: 2 digital images

November 28, 2023

Motion

Maker's image could include Motion Blur or Stop Motion. For Motion Blur, add a slight blur of the action to help your image tell a story. Blur the background or the subject. For Stop Motion, showcase a dramatic moment by freezing the action.

Submission limit: 2 digital images

Do not resize your digital image

The minimum resolution is 1280 x 800
